13:00	All the teams will eat at the tables provided in the marquee. This is when the judges will come round and taste your food.
13:30	Clear your site and washing up, further judgment will be made on the cleanliness of the site after use.
14:30	Announcement of the winners.
15:00	Flag down and departure.

What you need to bring

Each group needs to bring their food, cooking and eating utensils, washing up kit and some type of shelter in case it rains. Some spare equipment is available, but supplies are limited so make sure you try and bring everything you will need. Alter fires and wood will be supplied by Bonaly.



Competition Rules

Working in teams of up to six, Scouts have to cook a three-course meal on alter fires. You are allowed to bring pot, pans and cooking utensils; however, our judges will be particularly impressed with backwoods cooking techniques. Each team must plan their own menu and produce a shopping list for ingredients. The budget is £3.50 per person.

Judging

We will be judging the quality of the food, understanding of allergens, healthy eating and food hygiene. Also, camp craft, clean-up and LNT (Leave No Trace). "Our judges will be particularly impressed by teams using Backwoods cooking techniques."
