Standard Operating Procedure – All Activities

Activity leaders will be given copies of the Standard Operating Procedure, Risk Assessment and Instructions for the activity.

The safety of participants is at all times the responsibility of the supervisor.

The supervisor must:

Read and comply with the Standard operating procedure, Risk Assessment and Activity instructions.

Complete the sign out sheet before using the activity

Must supervise the activity for its entire duration and not hand over responsibility to any other person at any time.

Ensure there is adequate first aid provision.

Maintain adequate group control at all times.

Ensure participants are suitably attired for the prevailing weather conditions and activity.

Be aware of any participant medical conditions that may affect the activity.

Make participants aware of conditions underfoot.

Fully brief participants on the activity, paying particular attention to risks highlighted in the Risk Assessments and Standard Operating Procedures.

Report any loss or damage to the equipment/activity.

Standard Operating Procedure – ESCAPE!

Activity leaders must be particularly vigilant for the below risks

Shark Island

- Participants must not jump between the platforms
- The plank must only be supported by team members standing on one end to act as a counterbalance. Participants must not hold the plank in any way i.e., using hands, sitting on it, supporting from underneath with toes etc.

Unexploded Bomb

- Participants not operating a guide rope must be outside the red boundary rope.
- Participants operating the ropes must stand in the designated areas (hoops on the ground).
- The ropes are to be pulled slowly and gently to prevent the lifting hook swinging out of controls and hitting a anyone.
- Ropes must not be operated while the activity is being reset.

Acid Lake

- Crates must be passed between participants; they must not be thrown.
- Crates must not be moved in any way while participants are standing on them no holding crates and jumping them.
- Participants must not jump between crates.
