What Does a Youth Lead Do?

Youth Leads are the champions of youth-shaped Scouting here in South East Scotland! As a Youth Lead, you'll be at the heart of bringing young people's voices to life in your district, teaming up with volunteers to make sure our programmes stay fresh, relevant, and shaped by the ideas of the young people themselves.

Aged 18-24 at the time of joining, Youth Leads act as a bridge between young people's ideas and the volunteers who bring them to life. You'll be guiding our Scouting programme, inspiring both young Scouts and adult volunteers to work together, share ideas, and keep the energy high.

What does that look like day-to-day? It'll vary by district, but here's a taste:

- Helping volunteers bring young people's ideas into action so that each section's programme reflects what they really want.
- Promoting awards and achievements—including top awards and youth-shaped recognitions across the district.
- **Encouraging young people to step up** and lead, whether it's joining the Young Leader's Scheme or finding other ways to make their mark.
- Sharing all the amazing opportunities Scouting has to offer—and helping young people know what's out there as they turn 18 and beyond.
- Being a key part of the District Trustee Board so young people's voices have a say in decisions that matter.
- **Gathering ideas and feedback** from young people across the district to keep our programme exciting, relevant, and youth-led.

As a Youth Lead, you'll work closely with the District Lead Volunteer, who'll help set goals and support you as you shape the future of Scouting in your district. You'll also connect with the Regional Youth Lead and Youth Lead for Scotland, who are there to back you up and make sure you've got the resources you need.

Ready to make a difference? With your creativity, passion, and leadership, you'll help keep Scouting in South East Scotland exciting, empowering, and fully youth-shaped!

All About the Role - District Youth Lead

Role Description:

As **District Youth Lead for Craigalmond**, you'll be an essential part of the District Leadership Team, working alongside the District Lead Volunteer and the Chairperson of the District Trustee Board. Your mission? To make sure young people aged 4–25 are truly at the heart of every decision that shapes their Scouting experience in your district. From planning to reviewing programmes, you'll empower young people to speak up, share their ideas, and help shape the Scouting adventures they want.

Who You'll Work With:

• Responsible to: District Lead Volunteer for Craigalmond

Regional Youth Lead as a member of the Regional Youth Team

- Responsible for: Craigalmond District Youth Team
- Main Contacts: Young people in Craigalmond district, District Lead Volunteer,
 District teams (like the 14-24 team and Programme team), Regional Youth Lead,
 District Chairperson, District Trustee Board members, and other local District
 Youth Leads from across South East Scotland.

Requirements:

- Age: 18-24 at the start of the role
- **Eligibility**: You must be eligible to become a Charity Trustee

What You'll Do:

- Champion Youth-Led Scouting: Work with the District Lead Volunteer, District Chairperson, and District Team to make sure Scouting across Craigalmond is shaped by young people, in collaboration with adults.
- **Build a District Youth Team**: Bring together a team of young people from across Craigalmond to help lead the way.
- **Join the District Trustee Board**: As an ex-officio Trustee, you'll ensure that young people have a voice in key decisions.
- **Support Youth-Led Scouting in Programmes**: Work to include young people in local decision-making at all levels.
- **Widen Your Impact**: Stay connected with the broader District work, passing on any National and Regional updates that can help the district.



• **Drive Real Change**: Make sure youth-led Scouting has a strong and visible impact across your district.

Note: Some of these responsibilities might be shared with others, including your District Youth Team.








Craigalmond District Structure
