3	Getting hit by Tomahawks	Instructors, participants & other site users	High	Designated Tomahawk throwing area roped off, warning signs in place, Instructor aware of danger and to monitor area. Net in place if appropriate. Instructor to control when Tomahawks are thrown and collected. All spectators to stay in the spectator areas only. Only two participants allowed in throwing area. All participants to throw from the throwing line and not cross it until authorised by the instructor. Maximum of two participants throwing at the same time. Instructor to maintain group control at all times.	Low
1	Hypo/Hyperthermia and exposure	Participants	Medium	Instructors to ensure participants have appropriate clothing for the prevailing conditions and to monitor participants during the session.	Low

### Bonaly Scout Centre – Activity Risk Assessment & SOP

#### **Standard Operating Procedure – All Activities**

Supervisors will be given copies of the Standard Operating Procedure, Risk Assessment and Instructions for the activity.

The safety of participants is at all times the responsibility of the supervisor.

The supervisor must:

Read and comply with the Standard operating procedure, Risk Assessment and Activity instructions.

Complete the sign out sheet before using the activity

Must supervise the activity for its entire duration and not hand over responsibility to any other person at any time.

Ensure there is adequate first aid provision.

Maintain adequate group control at all times.

Ensure participants are suitably attired for the prevailing weather conditions and activity.

Be aware of any participant medical conditions that may affect the activity.

Make participants aware of conditions underfoot.

Fully brief participants on the activity, paying particular attention to risks highlighted in the Risk Assessments and Standard Operating Procedures.

Report any loss or damage to the equipment/activity.

### **Standard Operating Procedure – Soft Tomahawks**

Maximum group size per supervisor of 12

The supervisor must:

Check equipment prior to use.

Give clear instructions for the task.


Maintain adequate group control at all time

Suspend activity if weather is unsuitable i.e slippery surfaces.

Ensure no one is behind the target or the thrower.

Set up the range as shown below; or have a barrier (e.g. wall, net etc.) behind the target
